For those who don't know, we felt the Lord confirm and call us to Sheridan, WY in July 2021. We bought land within 1 month, sold our businesses and CA home over the next 6 months, left CA in January 2022, lived on the road in our 5th wheel for 1 year while building a new home, and moved in exactly 1 year ago next week. Our 1st trip here we found a church which remained our home church as we popped in during the build and until this summer of 2023.

Then we took a leap of faith last August to obey God and change churches. This meant driving 40 minutes away. For anyone who has been a part of a church family (especially our 1st one here in WY), it is never easy. These were the only friends we had here. But we follow Jesus, not our friends. Maybe that's a word for someone else right now ... And I can tell you, God KNEW what we needed.

As bad as many think CA is, the opposition there made the Light shine ever brighter (at least in our experience). We were surrounded by "on fire" Believers! We had a wonderful church, we were well fed sheep with expository, line by line teaching, rich in doctrine, and alive in The Spirit. We got to witness how the other messes that came with California created a desperation and NEED for Jesus, and we saw God moving mountains and adding to the numbers daily. In Wyoming, life is easier in SOME ways. But the desperate NEED for Jesus is not as tangible.

We've wrestled, grieved, repented and prayed about so much these last 2 years. BUT...it has made us devour the Scriptures like never before. It has given us a renewed love for The Body of Christ. It has made us <u>depend</u> on Jesus above all else. And it has made us *solidify our theology!* We've had to make some uncomfortable or necessary changes or sacrifices at times. But God has been at work behind the scenes (as always!)... and we are seeing Him move constantly since August!!!

To give you a little background... I've had this "knowing" (which also means many seasons of "doubting", tension in marriage, all the things... keepin it real) for 15 years, that God has had a calling on Zach's life, but it hasn't been the time. There's been decades of refining, maturing, shifting, moving, and preparation taking place (by faith I'll say...for such a time as this). Zach has never sought to "take the pulpit." He is well aware and respectfully terrified of the responsibility that comes with teaching & rightly dividing The Word. A healthy and reverent "fear of God" is a good

place to be in light of all the vying, striving and selfish ambition that takes place in much of what we call "ministry" or "church" today. There is so much ear tickling, pastor worship, drama, performance and "making things happen," that we have wrestled through all the mess that comes with "church." And we are also well aware we too are sinners who are unworthy, who fall short all too often, and we are part of the problem.

That said, Zach started Bible College this year and then, to our surprise and in God's abundant mercy, our pastor recently asked Zach to teach a Christmas message. He then asked him to start teaching at our church once a month. We did not see this coming. Nonetheless, Zach has prayerfully answered the call for now. While we do not know what God has planned for the future, we are enjoying seeing a little revival happen in this little community south of us called Buffalo, WY and also here in the Bible Study we host in our home here in Sheridan, WY with a few other local families. God used our pastor to see something in Zach and challenge him to step up.

I've gotten to watch the Lord sift, strengthen, work, confirm, embolden, humble, and prepare Zach for the occasion this past Sunday. To witness the Holy Spirit training someone in their Spiritual gifting is pretty amazing. It's been a long (hard) road (to say the least!) ... Maybe I'll get that book written one day after all and share all the details... Until then... here is Sunday's message for anyone who needs to be exhorted & encouraged:
